SECOND CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

(October 2022)

The National Council for Cultural Heritage Cultural of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Cuba calls for the First International Congress on Cultural Heritage.

Aware of the need to strengthen processes aimed at the protection and safeguarding of the diversity of expressions of Cultural Heritage in view of the challenges imposed by prevailing development models and by the consequences of climate change, as well as by the still unsatisfied potentialities of a better assessment and enjoyment of these goods and the intangible manifestations of communities and visitors, the Congress aims at creating spaces for collective reflection to face the challenges of managing the Cultural Heritage, particularly in Latin America and the Caribbean.

We call researchers, students, cultural promoters and managers, leaders and staff in public institutions and the communities in general to discuss topics related to the protection and safeguarding of Cultural Heritage. To this aim, the Congress will offer not only the spaces for presentations and discussions, but also workshops and specialized tours.
