

TICCIH Elections 2025: Key Questions & Answers

As announced previously, the elections connected with this year's TICCIH General Assembly to be celebrated in Kiruna, Sweden, on Friday, August 29, will take place remotely and before the congress. This allows people, who are eligible to vote and cannot attend the World Congress physically, to participate properly, while at the same time we free time for Board members present in Kiruna to start working on the future.

We anticipate frequently asked questions in relation to that, and here are some answers:

Who has the right to vote?

Our current statutes define that in each country where TICCIH has at least five members registered in its international membership system, these can group together and designate one person from their group as their National Representative.

Please note that this voting system is about to change and planned to be replaced by a one-person-one-vote system in the next term.

When and how will the voting take place?

Our Headquarters will contact the persons who have been identified as eligible to vote by email very soon.

The voting will take place remotely during a time period starting on August 1 and ending on August 10 at midnight.

The voting will be organized via a Google form, though which the votes can be cast.

What will the votes be about?

The following three things are put forward by the current TICCIH Board for approval by the people eligible to vote, and will be shared publicly with the membership:

1. Minutes of the TICCIH General Assembly 2022 in Montreal
2. Financial Report 2022-2025
3. TICCIH Board composition and tasks 2025-2028

Who will manage the process?

Daniel Schneider from our Headquarters is in charge of managing the voting process. He is the primary contact person for all people who are eligible to vote.
